

# Surprise Lake Camp - Camper Kit List

(CLEARLY LABEL ALL BELONGINGS WITH YOUR NAME)

## **CLOTHING** *(Please bring OLD clothing)*

- At least 3 sweaters/sweatshirts (at least one with a hood)
- At least 4 pairs of long pants (more for longer camps)
- At least 5 shirts (more for longer camps)
- A few pairs of shorts
- Sun hat or Ball cap
- Underwear (for each day of camp PLUS 3-4 EXTRA)
- Socks (you can never bring too many pairs of socks)
- Swimsuit
- Warm Pajamas
- Nice outfit for banquet dinner ~Optional~

## **FOOT WEAR**

- At least 2 pairs of outdoor shoes (suitable for hiking!)
- 1 pair indoor shoes/slippers (for Dining Hall)
- Sandals
- Rubber boots ~optional~
- Water shoes (suitable for the lake) ~Optional~

## **PERSONAL HYGENE**

- Sunscreen (at least SPF 30. WATER PROOF)
- 2-3 Towels and facecloth
- Beach towel
- Shampoo/Conditioner (no phosphates please\*)
- Soap (must also be environmentally friendly\*)
- Tooth Brush & Tooth Paste

- Brush or Comb
- Insect repellent
- Kleenex

## **OUTERWEAR**

- Heavy Jacket (Preferably one with a hood)
- Rain coat or water resistant Jacket
- Mittens & Toque

## **SLEEPING GEAR**

- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Extra Blanket
- Groundsheet/foamy ~Optional~

## **OTHER**

- Flashlight (with extra batteries)
- 3 plastic garbage bags (for laundry)
- Pen or pencil, notebook
- Water Bottle
- Back pack (for hiking)
- Plain white T-shirt for crafts ~Optional~
- Camera & Film ~Optional~
- Money for a camp t-shirt ~Optional~

## **SLC SPECIAL**

- Really old clothes and old tie up shoes (for the Mud Walk... These clothes will get dirty really fast!)

## **Please keep in mind:**

- This packing list is only a guide to help you prepare for camp.
- Feel free to bring other things such as Sports equipment, Musical Instruments, Craft supplies, Dress-up clothes, a compass, books, pictures, prayers, graces, games, skits, stories, and songs.
- PLEASE do not bring - electrical appliances (i.e. curling irons, Walkmans, ipods etc...), matches, cigarettes or cell phones.
- \*Some shampoo/conditioner/soap brands that are phosphate free and environmentally friendly are: Aussie, Herbal essences and anything found at a natural foods store.
- CANDY - Candy is welcome at camp but is not a requirement on the packing list and is to be shared. If you wish to bring candy, please leave all treats with the camp cook upon arrival at camp. Candy will be stored in the kitchen and distributed at the discretion of the staff. Any left over treats will be returned to the camper when they are picked up at the end of their camp. (Please do not keep candy in your bags; it is an invitation for squirrels to join your cabin group).
- NOTE: We have no laundry facilities at Surprise Lake, so please bring enough clothing to last a whole camp; RAIN or SHINE. Often Campers go through more than one change of clothes per day. (ESPECIALLY SOCKS).
